

Cookies are files or pieces of information that may be stored on your computer (or other internet enabled devices, such as a smartphone or tablet) when a user's browser loads a particular website. A cookie will usually contain the name of the website from which the cookie has come from, the "lifetime" of the cookie (i.e. how long it will remain on your device), and a value, which is usually a randomly generated unique number. Therefore, when you return to websites or visit websites that use the same cookies — they recognize these cookies and your browsing device. Cookies permit to remember your preferences. We may use cookies to distinguish you from other users and to support the marketing of our services including evaluation of our site's advertising and promotional effectiveness. Cookies on COMPLY TODAY website help us to improve our sites and your user experience. Some cookies expire when the browser closes, while others remain on your computer unless you delete them. You may delete cookies whenever you like but by deleting cookies and disabling future cookies you may not be able to access certain areas or features of our site.

Consent to use of cookies

Cookies collect information about how visitors use the site, for instance which pages visitors go to most often, and if they get error messages from web pages. These cookies do not collect information which identifies a visitor and COMPLY TODAY will not use cookies to collect personally identifiable information about you. All information is aggregated and maintained anonymous. By using our website, you give consent that we can place these types of cookies on your device and agree that you understand this Cookies Policy.

How to control and delete cookies

Most internet browsers are initially set up to automatically accept cookies. You can change the settings to block cookies or to alert you when cookies are being sent to your device.
